The Gan Foundation for Cinema is one of the two foundations of the Groupama Group, one of France's largest insurance groups and whose societal commitment has over many years been its support for artistic creation. The Gan Foundation is strongly linked to the identity of the Gan company (one of the entities of the Groupama Group).

Since its creation, for more than 35 years ago, the Gan Foundation has lent its steadfast support to the emergence of new generations of filmmakers, promoting quality and originality in cinematic productions, from the writing of screenplays to the distribution of films in theatres, channelled through the Foundation's principal missions of Aid for Creation and Aid for Distribution.

Its guiding motto is "audacity, consistency and diversity".

## Aid for Creation

Aid for Creation consists of yearly awards given to four feature-length fiction films (first or second film projects) which are selected on the basis of their screenplays. Assisting the Foundation in choosing the award winners is a jury composed of figures from the cinema industry and which is presided by a former award winner.

Each awarded film receives €53,000, of which €3,000 is for the director and €50,000 for the producer. This aid can be increased in the form of technical contributions from industry partners. Today, the support given by the Foundation to film projects is also recognised as a mark of their quality, and is often established during the early fund-raising stages of their development.

## ★ Gan Assurances

Historically a provider of insurance services for professional players, Gan Assurances is today an insurer for all «enterprising» people in both their private and professional lives.

It is thus only natural that Gan Assurances leads, via its Foundation, a programme of patronage in favour of cinematographic creation and accompanies those who are «cinema entrepreneurs». The 915 Gan Assurances agents enjoy the support of the Foundation and are given access to a catalogue of films for the organization of public relations events, in the form of evening film screenings, or national quiz competitions. These represent unique opportunities to invite customers, partners and also staff, offering a privileged environment that combines conviviality, pleasure and culture.

## Aid for Distribution

With its Aid for Distribution, the Foundation lends its support to various festivals through funding and the awarding of a special Distribution Prize (€20,000 for the French distributor of a film that has been honoured by the Foundation).

The Foundation is a partner of the Cannes International Critics' Week, and the Annecy International Animation Film Festival.

In 2023, the Foundation awarded a Distribution Prize for Amjad Al Rasheed's *INSHALLAH A BOY* at Cannes International Critics' Week, and for Chiara Malta and Sébastien Laudenbach's *CHICKEN FOR LINDA!* at the Annecy Festival.

## ★ A commitment spanning for more than 35 years!

At the 40th Cannes Film Festival, for more than 35 years ago, the assurances Gan group created its foundation. Costa-Gavras, then president of the Cinémathèque française, provided the inspiration for the field of activity of what would become France's leading corporate foundation dedicated to cinema, and for which he remains the honorary president. As of 1987, the GAN Foundation distinguished itself as a pioneer in its promotion of first films. Today, the Foundation's action is recognised as an essential contribution to cinema, as illustrated by the numerous awards it has itself received, including, on three occasions, France's Oscar du Mécénat (Oscar for Patronage) and the French culture ministry's Grand Mécène Gold Medal for patronage. Since 2015, the Gan Foundation has been a major sponsor of the Cinémathèque française.

## Filmmakers in their own words



FIRST IMAGES by Pierre-Henri Gibert – 30 Years Award, Part 2

As part of the celebrations for its 30 years of commitment to cinema creation, the Foundation teamed up in 2017 with Caimans Productions and Ciné+, for the production of a documentary series entitled FIRST IMAGES (French title, L'IMAGE ORIGINELLE), directed by Pierre-Henri Gibert.

FIRST IMAGES is a series of 26-minute documentaries in which renowned directors reflect on their very first films, in the context of what was to become their future work.

Olivier Assayas, Marco Bellocchio, Xavier Dolan, Naomi Kawase, Cédric Klapisch, Agnès Jaoui, David Lynch, Michel Ocelot, Joachim Trier and Lars von Trier are part of this collection.

In order to encourage exposure of the most diverse forms of cinema, the Gan Foundation attributes Special Awards to projects whose creation demonstrates notable ambition and originality. The Foundation has a particularly close and enduring relationship with animation film productions. Award winners include: ARCO by Ugo Bienvenu, PLANÈTES by Momoko Seto, BLIND WILLOW, SLEEPING WOMAN by Pierre Földes, THE SUMMIT OF THE GODS by Patrick Imbert, THE CROSSING by Florence Maïlhe, THE BEARS' FAMOUS INVASION OF SICILY by Lorenzo Mattotti, THE RED TURTLE by Michael Dudok de Wit and LONG WAY NORTH by Rémi Chayé.

## In a few figures



Since 2017, films supported by the Foundation have won 13 César awards

To date, the Foundation's various aid programmes have contributed to the emergence of more than 240 film directors, those who drive contemporary cinema and prepare that of tomorrow, and who are behind almost 700 completed works. Since the Foundation's creation:

- It has studied more than 5,000 screenplays and accompanied 92% of submitted film projects to the shooting stages.
- among its award winners, 40% have completed more than three films and 30% of award winners are women filmmakers.
- the films it has sponsored have received 41 awards at the French cinema industry's prestigious yearly César ceremonies, along with 35 awards at the Cannes Film Festival, including 1 Palme d'or.
